

# About the Band

Nevers' Second Regiment Band is the Capitol City's professional community band, dedicated to bringing an annual series of summer concerts to the greater Concord area and throughout the state. Its compound name derives from its military affiliation with the Second Regiment of the New Hampshire National Guard in the late 1800's and direction for more than half a century by Claremont cornetist, Arthur Nevers. 
1861 that accompanied the Third New Hampshire Regiment to Hilton Head, South Carolina. Throughout its years of service, Nevers' Band has remained a professional civilian community band, but its military origins have always flavored its history and traditions.

During its 150+ years, the band has only had 13 conductors! This notable list includes J. Wilkins Hall, Henri Blaisdell, Arthur Nevers, Herbert W. Rainie, James D. Bell, Paul T. Giles, Douglas Osborne, Maryanne Sisk, Richard C. Spicer, Jiffi Rainie, Rick Cook, Phil Martin and currently, Kevin M. Swift.

The band boasts not only the longevity of its conductors but the loyalty of our multi-generational membership of talented musicians who travel from all over NH to play. Nevers' Band is made up of teachers, students, doctors, composers, ministers, retired folks and professionals from all walks of life who want to explore the vast literature the band has to offer. Our diverse repertoire includes popular numbers, patriotic music, classic orchestral transcriptions, music from motion pictures and more! # Distinguished Performances

Some performances by the band included the dedication of the battleship USS Alabama and the 1905 signing of the Russo-Japanese Peace Treaty, both in Portsmouth, New Hampshire. Other events included the turn of the century political rallies, the Amoskeag Mills Grand Ball, Lancaster and Hopkinton Fairs, Dartmouth College Commencements, the dedication of Tram II at Cannon Mt., the opening of I-93 through Franconia Notch and the Eastern States Exposition. Nevers' Band prides itself on its historic past, its affiliation with the
